CONDITIONS OF BOAT STORAGE

1. A member owning a vessel and locating it on the Club premises, shall indemnify the Club against all actions, damages, costs and expenses to which the Club may become liable in respect of loss or damage to property or injury to persons wholly or in part by the location of such vessel in or on the Club premises.
2. Any changes in ownership shall be communicated immediately in writing to the Club.
3. Storage allocations are not transferrable should the boat be sold.
4. Storage of a vessel is renewable yearly.
5. Masts, sails and equipment must be confined within the boat or to the mast storage area. Boats failing to comply with this may have their storage allocation revoked.
6. The vessel on application of boat storage, shall be insured against Third Party property damage and injury and death to persons of not less than AUD \$10 million. (Recommend \$20 million).
7. The allocation and renewal of boat storage will be based upon on going participation. The club has the right to terminate storage allocations for those that do not participate sufficiently in Club activities; refer to club by laws.

The following items will be taken into consideration when allocating storage racks/bays or in the secure compound areas.

Regular participation

- Club racing
- Training Sessions
- Regattas & Club functions

Support & Leadership

- Attendance at Club meetings
- Serving Club / Sub-committee members

8. Trailers are NOT permitted to be stored or left overnight under any circumstances unless the vessel is contained on the trailer as an item in its bay within the compound. Trailers are NOT permitted in the dinghy shed.
9. Temporary storage for trailers may be allocated at the express permission of the Committee and MUST be stored in the trailer area at the back of the tractor shed. Charges will apply for long term storage.
10. Yachts / boats / trailers will be issued with a storage/compound sticker to be fixed to the stern of the vessel.
11. Do NOT move or interfere with any other boat or sundry equipment without the express permission of the owner concerned.
12. Boat building is not allowed within the compound. Maintenance work carried out must be minor in nature and comply with the relevant noise/dust regulations for the City of Busselton.
13. Members shall receive a storage sticker for the season, which MUST be placed on the hull as outlined in Schedule 2 and must be clearly visible at all times.

Sticker 1 to go on the Aft of boat on the starboard side (see photo)
Sticker 2 to go on trailer/trolley clearly visible
